Below are instructions on how to access the **episodectl** interface and the help document which explains all the functions available in the CLI.

Accessing the CLI – MAC

In a default installation episodectl is located in:

/Applications/Episode.app/Contents/MacOS/engine/bin/

- If you find typing the full path inconvenient you can either add that directly to your PATH, or put a link to **episodectl** in one of the directories in your PATH.
- To access the help document, type the following command: episodectl -h | --help
- This will display the help document for episodectl, listing all the commands available as well as descriptions of their use.

Accessing the CLI – WIN

- In a default installation episodectl is located in:
 C:\Program Files\Telestream\Episode 6\bin
- To access the help document, type the following command: episodectl -h | --help
- This will display the help document for **episodectl**, listing all the commands available as well as descriptions of their use.
